Elementary Engineering and Coding

Embed engineering and computer coding concepts across all subjects in 141 elementary schools

Support teacher training and hands-on learning activities

Promote continuing interest in STEM

Teach logic skills as early as Kindergarten



Cyber Patriot Clubs Cyber IT Courses

Sponsor CyberPatriot clubs in middle schools to capture student interest in the field and expand enrollment in high school cyber courses

Expand Cyber IT curriculum to all 25 high schools and make it available to all high school students to inspire them to pursue career and/or further education avenues

Offer dual-enrolled high school courses with NVCC
